# The latest for IT Specialist educators

### IT Specialist Device Configuration and Management exam update coming in February

As Microsoft prepares to retire Windows 10 this year, in parallel we have updated the IT Specialist Device Configuration and Management exam with Windows 11 concepts.

We have made minor adjustments to the objective domains for Windows 10 and Windows 11, specifically the addition of objective 2.2 and the incorporation of Windows Hello to objective 4.2 of the Windows 11 exam. If you have a license, voucher, or inventory for Device Configuration and Management, you will not need to make any updates to your testing center.

When learners are ready for the exam, they should select the Device Configuration and Management exam. They will be given the option to choose Device Configuration and Management Windows 10 or Device Configuration and Management Windows 11, depending on which platform they used to prepare. The certificate will be the same but the score report will reflect Windows 10 or Windows 11.

Our valued learning partners are working as quickly as possible to update their content to reflect this change. We are anticipating LearnKey, GMetrix and Brain Buffet to have their content reflect Windows 11 throughout this year.
