Expirations, closures, and resources

We're adding expiration dates to our certifications

Starting June 18, 2025, we'll be adding expiration dates to many of our certification programs. The Cisco Certified Support Technician certification expiration dates will be added on July 15, 2025, with a reminder sent at that time.

Why expiration dates?

This change will:

- Ensure the certifications validate up-to-date skills and knowledge
- Align certifications with industry standards and current technologies
- Drive additional value and credibility for certification holders

People who have earned a certification before June 18 will see no change to their current certifications, nor will they expire. After this date, people will start to see expiration information appear on our website and on their certificates.

When do certifications expire?

Most certifications will be valid for five years, except:

- Adobe Certified Professional certifications will continue to expire after three years
- Meta Certified Digital Marketing Associate will continue to expire after two years
- Microsoft Certified Fundamentals will not implement an expiration policy on their exams

MOS 2016 exams to be removed from Compass Cloud

Effective **July 15**, **2025**, Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) 2016 exams will no longer be available for Compass Cloud delivery in the following languages: Arabic, Chinese (Simplified), Dutch, French, German, Italian, Korean, Polish, Portuguese, Romanian, Spanish, Thai, Turkish, and Vietnamese.

These exams will remain available for Compass Local delivery until the retirement of MOS 2016 on **June 30**, **2026**. We encourage users of this version to update to the most recent MOS certifications.
