

Reviewing Items Later

You can select the "Review Later" check box (located below each question) to flag questions that you want to return to later. At the end of the section or exam, you will see the questions that you have marked for review.

Leaving Feedback on Questions

You can select the "Leave Feedback" check box (located below each question) to flag questions for which you want to provide comments after you finish the exam. The time allocated for leaving feedback is separate from the exam time. You cannot transfer any remaining exam time to the time allocated for leaving feedback.

Keyboard Shortcuts

You can use keyboard shortcuts to perform certain functions within the exam. To display information about the available keyboard shortcuts, select the "Help" button associated with the question.

Viewing Content

To display all the question text or answer choices, you might need to move the scroll bar that appears when content is not visible on the screen. Before answering the question, look for the scroll bar and ensure that you have read all of the question text and answer choices. To see more or less of the question or answer text, move the horizontal splitter bar (divider) between the question area and answer area.

Case Studies

This exam might contain case studies. Case studies are not timed separately from other exam sections. Pay attention to the Exam Progress (at the top of the screen) to ensure that you have sufficient time to complete any exam sections that follow the case study.

The number of case studies and associated questions are displayed on the Welcome Screen and on the screen shown immediately before you start the exam. Case studies are also visible in the Exam Progress menu.






